Here at Thousand Pines we offer a variety of Recreational Options. If you would like to participate in a recreational option, you will need to sign a contract for the activity and the number of participants. The activities are booked on a first come, first served basis according to the dates of the returned contracts.

Ropes Course: The Thousand Pines Ropes course offers a variety of physically challenging elements designed to instill confidence in individuals as well as to strengthen the cohesiveness of groups. The Ropes course is facilitated by our trained staff that encourages, support and stretch the faith of the participants. There is a \$5.00 per person charge for the ropes course which includes a low ropes course, rock climbing, and the 400' zip-line. *Because of the nature of this activity you must be at least 75 lbs. to participate.* Closed toed shoes, and long shorts or pants, are required. **Please note: For your safety the Ropes Course will be closed in inclement weather.*



Paintball: Paintball is one of our most popular venues. Whether your group is full of experienced shooters or people who have never played before, Thousand Pines paintball gives you the opportunity to be competitive, strategic, get dirty and most importantly for each participant to practice teamwork and good sportsmanship. There is a \$10.00 per person charge for paintball which

includes all necessary equipment and 150 rounds of paint. Extra paint is available for purchase at the field for \$2.50 for 100 rounds or a case of 2000 for \$40.00.

Because of the nature of this venue each participant must be at least 12 years old to play. Closed toed shoes, and long shorts or pants, are required.



If you are interested in the above activities or in these other options: (Mountain Bikes, Skate Park, Games, all which are \$5.00 per person with a \$25.00 minimum) contact the Guest Relations department and ask for a contract.

We also offer the following venues upon advanced request without a contract:

Swimming Pool: The pool is open seasonally from Memorial Day through Labor Day during free time for all the groups to use. It will be closed if none of the groups have expressed interest in its use. Please let us know if your group will be using the pool during free time. If you would like exclusive use of the pool at a time other than Sat between 1:00 and 5:00, inquire. *(The pool closes during lightning storms.)*

Malt Shop: The malt shop can be opened upon your request in the evenings or during afternoon free time.

The Big Oak Cafe: The Oak Tree Café offers great choices for coffees, teas, & hot cocoa and offers a gift shop to go shopping in. The Oak Tree Café can be opened upon your request in the evenings or during afternoon's free time.

The Art Shop: If your group loves to be creative or just wants a way to remember their Thousand Pines experience the art shop is the place to visit. We offer a variety of crafts including hat and t-shirt design, leather, ceramics and wood painting. Prices in the art shop range from \$1.00-\$15.00 depending on the project.

Recreation Bucket: A recreation bucket contains Frisbees disks and maps to the Frisbee golf course, a basketball (one hoop), soccer, volleyball, ping pong paddles, foosballs, and (upon request) horseshoes. There is a small fee for unreturned items.
